LETTER TO THE HISTORIC YORKSHIRE NEIGHBORHOOD

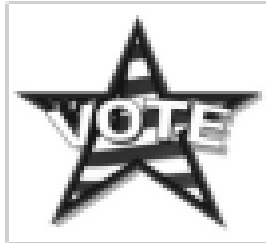
Dear neighbors and HYA members,


