Join us at Burlington City Council's Community Town Hall meeting in Ward 1. The Saturday afternoon Ward 1 Town Hall feedback session will be held at 1 pm, on April 13, 2024, at the Corson Poley Center.

This is the first City Council Town Hall since COVID. Unlike the City Council's regularly scheduled meetings that follow formal Roberts Rules of Order and strict meeting protocols, the April 13th Ward 1 Town Hall in New Yorkshshire is one of City of Burlington Council's informal information feedback. This is an opportunity for you to bring up issues specific to

your neighborhood and obtain a personal response from Council Members or the Mayor.

The Burlington Historical Society has offered its building for the Ward 1 communities to have Saturday access to the April 13th Ward 1 Town Hall. The Corson Poley Center has an entrance on two sides, behind 451 High Street and at 454 Lawrence Street. The Lawrence Street entrance includes a parking lot, and there is street parking on High Street for the front entrance. So, come join us with your questions and concerns and let your voice be heard. Please bring your friends, family, and neighbors with you.



NEW BULK TRASH PICK UP SCHEDULE FOR 2024



Residents must call Public Works Garage at **609-386-0754** *before noon the Wednesday prior* to schedule bulk trash pickup. After scheduled, place your limit of 2 items at the curb for pickup *the night before pickup.*

Bulk pickup items include: sofas, chairs, recliners, tables, (bagged) mattresses and box springs, other wood furniture. Bulk DOES NOT include: construction debris, appliances, household bagged trash, metal items and electronic equipment, computers, TVs, printers, etc.

Bulk Pickup Dates: April 5 and 19; May 3 and 17; June 1, 14, and 28; July 12 and 26; August 9 and 23; September 7 and 20; October 4 and 18; November 1, 15, and 30; and December 15 and 28.

LADLE OF LOVE'S 20TH ANNIVERSARY

Ladle of Love, at St. Mary's Episcopal Church, celebrated its 20th Anniversary on February 4, 2024. This food ministry, started by two parishioners who recognized a need for food assistance in Burlington City, changed from a sit-down dinner meal every Wednesday, to an expanded Food Pantry with the onset of the Covid-19 pandemic. It continues as a Food Pantry affiliated with the Food Bank of South Jersey.

In 2023, Ladle of Love Food Pantry provided supplemental food to 580 households in - and around - Burlington. In those households are 1,830 individuals. They come 1-3 times a month... on foot, bicycle, car, or train.

Each Ladle of Love day, 80-105 households "shop" for groceries at St. Mary's Guild House. If you're looking for a way to contribute to your community, just call or text Bernadette Boyle 856-534-1816 for a list of volunteer opportunities.

Ladle of Love Food Pantry is open from 4-6 p.m. the 2nd, 3rd, & 4th Wednesday of the month. Proof of New Jersey residency is required to receive most kinds of food.



DOG LICENSE RENEWALS



Dog licenses are available from the Health Division/Registrar, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., Tuesday through Friday at City Hall Municipal Offices 525 High Street Burlington NJ, (609) 386-0200 ext. 137.

You will need to provide a certificate of rabies vaccination and proof of spaying or neutering, if done. Fees are \$8/year for dogs that are spayed or neutered and \$11/year for dogs NOT spayed or neutered.
